

# Anti-Apartheid Pledge to Demand U.S. Officials Act Fairly and Justly on All Matters Related to Israel-Palestine

Summary	
Demand 1.	All elected representatives advocate for an immediate ceasefire in Gaza and a de-escalation of hostilities in the West Bank.
Demand 2.	Domestically, elected representatives pledge their commitment to uphold and enact legislation that protects the civil rights of allies against the Israeli Apartheid.
Demand 3.	U.S. policy makers and elected representatives halt U.S. foreign aid to Israel and advocate for a just and equitable state that protects the rights and addresses the concerns of Palestinians.

## **Full Text**

Until the objectives of each demand are met, I pledge to remain steadfast and committed to the Israeli Anti-Apartheid movement. Furthermore, until all the demands outlined below are adopted, I, as an ally, will remain committed to advocacy and taking concrete action to call on all elected U.S. representatives and policy makers to enact legislation and policies that align with said demands.

#### Demand 1:

For as long as hostilities continue, I call on all U.S. elected representatives to advocate for an immediate ceasefire in Gaza and a de-escalation of hostilities in the West Bank and Jerusalem. Furthermore, I demand that such representatives demand Israel stops discriminating against and infringing on the rights Israeli citizens of Palestinian origin.

#### Demand 2:

I call on all elected representatives and those in positions of power to sign the Arab American Voter Project's two-pronged pledge, demanding leaders affirm their commitment to enacting policies that treat Israel-Palestine with impartiality abroad; while domestically, ensuring the equal treatment and protection of civil liberties for all Americans in the U.S., including, but not limited to, Palestinian Americans, Arab Americans, Muslim Americans and Jewish Americans. Such protection includes Americans legal right to advocate and protest for and against actions taken by the state of Israel, Zionism, Palestinian rights and any other issues that relate to Israel-Palestine.

#### Demand 3:

All elected representatives affirm their commitment and advocate for a lasting solution to the conflict that equally and equitably addresses the concerns of the Palestinian people. Such a proposition affirms the undeniability of a plausible two state solution and, instead, works within a two nations, one state framework or federation plan.
